

Churches in PRINCE ALBERT, REGINA and SASKATOON

- Members/adherents attending indoor public worship services must wear non-medical masks. From the information we have on hand, this includes the entire service and any social interaction before and after. We don't yet have clarity on mask wearing for the worship teams or speaker as they lead the service, but as it presently reads, they must (stay tuned here). The SK. government will review policy after 28 dates.

SASKATCHEWAN INDOOR PRIVATE GATHERINGS

- Maximum allowance is now 10 people (including residents of the home).
- Includes any structure on private property.
- This would include support groups, small groups, etc.
- Any gathering larger than 10 must meet in a public setting (eg. Church) and abide by the guidelines for that setting. You can move the home gatherings to the church and have 30 people (socially distanced). Keep maximums in mind for the entire space. However, they must now wear masks if the church is in PRINCE ALBERT, REGINA or SASKATOON!
