

Reaching & Teaching

Reaching & Teaching International Ministries utilizes a nine-module training program designed to provide deep theological education, biblical discipleship, and pastoral leadership training to church leaders globally. The curriculum focuses on strengthening local churches through a three-year cycle of week-long training sessions, targeting **heads** (doctrine), **hearts** (character), and **hands** (ministry practice).

Core Components of the Nine Modules

While specific curricula may be adapted, the comprehensive nine-module program typically covers the following areas to equip pastors and leaders:

- **Old Testament:** Understanding the foundational narrative of Scripture (May 2026)
- **New Testament:** Studying the life of Christ and the early church (July 2026)
- **Hermeneutics:** Proper interpretation of the Bible
- **Church Doctrine:** Foundations of Christian theology (March 2027)
- **Church History:** Learning from the historical church (July 2027)
- **Ecclesiology:** Theology and purpose of the healthy church
- **Missions and Church Planting:** Strategies for expanding God's kingdom (March 2028)
- **Expositional Preaching:** Communicating God's word faithfully (July 2028)
- **Family Ministry and Counseling:** Practical care for households

Training Structure

The curriculum aims to produce "healthy indigenous churches" that are biblically ordered and capable of training their own leaders.

- **Structure:** Nine total modules taught over three years, usually with three modules taught per year.
- **Schedule:** A typical trip consists of five days of teaching and two days of travel.
- **Approach:** Each module involves 30–40 hours of intensive study focusing on biblical theology.
- **Partnership:** The program works with local churches in over 40 countries to conduct on-site training.
