**All: Amen. Thanks be to God!**

*Take a moment and try to make a connection between the picture here and a truth about God, faith, and life. Let the Holy Spirit who is within you lead and guide you- and then see what happens!*

Leader: Let's speak the Apostles' Creed together:


**All: I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth. And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.**

Leader: Let's pray a blessing on God's Holy Word:

**All: Lord, thank You for the gift of grace that is Your Word. Help us to listen, learn, and grow. Holy Spirit, You are welcome here! Please accomplish Your work in us today. In Jesus' name. Amen.**

From the Bible, read Psalm 145. If gathered as a family, consider reading verse-by-verse.

## Think/Talk About It



1. What is something that you do every... single... day? See if you can list 10 different things you do each and every day.
2. In Psalm 145:2, what does King David say that he will do every day?
3. Then in Psalm 145:3, David explains why. Why, exactly, is it good and right for all of us to praise God? Read through the following verses in Psalm 145 to discover more: v.6, v.8, v.13, v.15.
4. Now make a second list- a list of 10 reasons why God has been great to you and your family in this past year- and why He is worthy of your praise.

Take time to pray to God. Remember the "2 Best Prayers We Know": "Thank You for..." and "Please help..."

**All: Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.**
