A House Is Not a Home – Part 3

Church Theme: Relight: Assemble · Align · Advance

Emphasis: Renewing covenant with God and recommitting to the house

Scripture Focus: Joshua 24:15-24

A house is not a home without God's presence, purpose, and passion. This house represents our being (personal devotion), our abode (family life), and our assembly (the body of believers).

When was the last time my relationship with God felt alive, not just faithful? What was different then?

What currently ignites my passion for God—and what quietly dulls it? Which best describes my current spiritual fire? (Burning / Routine / Cooling / Rekindling)

Do I pursue God primarily out of desire, discipline, or duty? Where have I mistaken activity for passion?

What spiritual commitments do I keep only when I feel like it? Where has my obedience become conditional instead of committed? How do I respond when God asks me to wait, release, or obey without clarity?

What truth about God must I stand on when my emotions fluctuate? What occupies my thoughts when I am tired, overwhelmed, or afraid?

Where is God inviting me to decide, not drift?

What do I protect most from God's interference? If someone evaluated my time, energy, and resources, what would they say I love most? Where is my life productive but not fruitful?

Which 'small god' feels too useful to let go of? What attachment has God already confronted—but I have postponed addressing? What part of my spiritual life feels staged instead of surrendered?

If God rearranged my life for His pleasure, what would change first? What habit, mindset, or pattern must be dismantled for me to move forward?

What does freedom look like for me in this season? Where have I tried to rush fulfillment instead of embracing formation?

Who or what is God asking me to leave behind so I can walk ahead?

What would obedience cost me right now—and am I willing to pay it?

What does serving the Lord with my whole house look like practically?

Where do I need to stop saying ‘later’ and start saying ‘today’?

What decision would most clearly demonstrate passion rooted in conviction? Who can witness my decision and help hold me accountable?
