

1. We are glad you are joining us for Easter Services whether is it on-line or outside in the parking lot at 7:00 am or 10:00 am.
2. A recorded service will be broadcast on ZOOM and Facebook at 10:00 am
3. The outdoor services will not be broadcast.
4. The services will be conducted by the Cross near the Narthex entrance.
5. If there is inclement weather, the outdoor services will be cancelled. We will not move the service inside.
6. Bring a chair and a mask. For the protection of everyone, masks are required at all times and social distancing outside the family unit is expected.
7. Park away from the building so that we have room to socially distance.
8. Individually packaged Communion elements will be provided. You may also bring your own elements.
9. There will be a basket for your offering.
10. There will be pre-recorded music played through a PA system. We will not have a choir or congregational singing.
11. We look forward to worshipping together.
