



## Grateful for Your Generosity – 1200 families get Thanksgiving Dinner, January 5, 2018

Last November, at Christ Our King Presbyterian Church in Bel Air, over 250 people spent a Saturday morning filling 1200 boxes of food for Thanksgiving. As a result, 300 families in Harford County received a frozen turkey and food for Thanksgiving dinner, plus food for additional meals. Through a joint effort with Knox Presbyterian Church and Grace Presbyterian Church, food was also distributed to an additional 850 families in Baltimore City. Fifty Maryland National Guard families throughout Maryland were also served.

The 1200 turkeys and boxes of non-perishable food supplied by Christ Our King Presbyterian Church were made possible by the generosity of church members, friends, and many local businesses and organizations.
