

REVIEW QUESTIONS

Q: Why were the religious leaders asking Jesus questions?

A: They wanted to trick him into saying something illegal so that they could arrest him.

Q: What question did they ask him this time?

A: "Which is the greatest commandment in the Law.

Q: What did Jesus say were the two greatest commandments?

A: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, your soul, your mind" and "Love your neighbor as yourself"

Q: What does it mean to love God with your heart, soul, and mind?

A: To love him with every single part of us! Our whole self.

ACTIVITY #1

CRAFT

Give each child a piece of paper. Have them fold it once in half and then fold the two edges backwards so the paper looks like an accordion.

On the two sides that fold together have the kids write "THE LAW" and draw what they think the Law looked like.

Then on the top and bottom folds have the kids glue the pieces of paper that have the two greatest commandments on them.

Have the kids color them however they would like and put their names on them.

They can fold it and show only the two commands or open it all the way and show the whole law.

Tell them that Jesus said that all the other laws fit into these two just like our craft!

(I know this is confusing so there will be a sample I made in the class on Sunday for you to use as an example)

ELEMENTARY GAME

Ninja

Have the kids stand in a circle (close enough they can reach each other, but far enough way they are not touching)

On kid starts and makes a ninja move towards the kid next to them without moving their feet. That kid must move to avoid the hit without moving their feet. Continue around the circle. If someone gets hit, they are out and the circle gets smaller.

Whoever is left and the end, is the winner.

Play as many rounds as you would like/time allows.
