Each week, the Presbytery of Lake Michigan lifts one of our faith communities in prayer as part of their mission in Christ. This week Westminster Presbyterian, Jackson, MI would like prayers that:

- **Living Bread continues introducing us to people who feel more at home in a less traditional setting for worship and a fellowship meal.** We started this weekly outreach event as part of the 1001 New Worshiping Communities program and pray that God will continue to draw people to this gathering.
- **We will find others to use our Gathering Space.** We were saddened when the preschool that rented space in our building for more than 25 years closed two years ago but realize it opens opportunities to share our building with community. Pray that we remember the vision glimpsed through the years of Westminster being a center where people can come for various kinds of support.
- **The Jackson Personal Care Ministry continues to provide 15 non-food consumable necessities of life** like toiletries, cleaning products and toilet paper to about 100 households each week. Westminster Presbyterian and several partner congregations started the ministry and pray for continued financial support for as long as it is needed.
- **Our ongoing ministry partnership with the Family Service and Children's Aid grows** as we and other volunteers help develop the Guardianship program. FSCA staff handles legal functions for more than 350 clients; volunteers will help provide "friendly," supportive visits. We celebrate this growing partnership.
- **God's vision for the future will be clear as we address the same challenges facing so many congregations today:** a desire to do vital ministry with fewer members, a higher-than-average age of participants, and a smaller budget.

We, at Westminster Presbyterian Church, think of ourselves as "The Little Church with the Big Heart." God's grace has openly welcomed us to the love and redemption that are ours through Jesus Christ. Reflecting the love that Jesus Christ offers to all, our congregation welcomes every person to our church community regardless of sexual orientation, color, gender identity, religious background, social or economic class, ethnicity nationality or ability.
