

Prayers and Squares

The Prayers and Squares Quilting group of Delta had an amazing and busy year. They made and distributed 79 quilts in 2023. These quilts were of various sizes and went to a variety of people and organizations: 4 to congregational care, 30 to Shared Pregnancy (an organization that provides emotional, material, and spiritual support through pregnancy and beyond), 13 to Sleep in Heavenly Peace (an organization that makes twin size beds for those in the community that otherwise would not have a bed), 27 to Country Stitches (a local quilt shop that distributes the quilts to a number of nursing homes and such organizations in the community), and finally 5 to the Adopt-A-Family that Delta supported this year. A thank you to all those that participate in or support the group. This photo is just a sample of the quilts made.

Budget \$141,500 = 92.3%

Results: Nov. Total Receipts \$9,215, Expenses \$14,466,

deficit of \$(5,251)

YTD results = Receipts \$138,230, Expense \$151,928,

deficit of \$(13,698).


