## In a World of Disaster, Hunger, and Oppression

Millions of people lack access to sustainable food sources, clean water, sanitation, education, and opportunity.

The three programs supported by <u>One Great Hour of Sharing</u> - Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, the Presbyterian Hunger Program, and Self-Development of People - all work in different ways to serve individuals and communities in need. From initial disaster response to ongoing community development, their work fits together to provide people with safety, sustenance, and hope. We participate in this offering during Lent. Our gifts improve life for people around the world and here in the United States.

#### Strategic Planning Team

After going through the Project Regeneration program with the Presbytery Foundation and the 40 days of prayer and discernment process, the Team believes we are being led by the Spirit to proceed toward a shared pastor model. Two churches each hire the pastor part-time with the two parts equating to a full time position for the pastor. This is NOT a merger but a collaboration where each congregation contracts the pastor.

We are excited with the possibilities this would create for both congregations and are exploring sharing a pastor, Ben Rumbaugh, with Dimondale First Presbyterian.

Our Strategic Planning Team met with Ben and seven members of Dimondale's Session on Monday, February 19 to begin exploring the feasibility of moving to a shared pastor model and what opportunities that will create for both congregations. All three parties are excited and decided to continue exploring where the Spirit is leading us and what this model would look like.

Nothing is certain at this time as there are many details yet to be discussed to make anything happen. Our Team requests your prayers as we continue our exploration. There will be a more in-depth update at the March 24 Congregational Meeting with a question and answer session to be included.

#### **Annual Meeting**

Time to Spring Ahead Our Annual Meeting of the Congregation and Corporation will take place on Sunday, March 24 following worship. Items on the agenda include receiving the Annual Report (which will be available by March 17), the Annual Meeting of the Corporation, electing a Nominating Committee, approving Wendy's retirement at the end of May, and receiving a report from the Strategic Planning Team with a Question and Answer period following.

#### **Court** of Honor

The Eagle Court of Honor has been referred to as Scouting's greatest moment. On Sunday, March 17, the Boy Scouts will have a Court of Honor at which two of the scouts will be honored for receiving scouting's highest rank, Eagle. This will follow our service and is scheduled to begin at 11:00. The congregation is encouraged to attend in support of the new Eagle Scouts and the entire scouting program here at Delta.



#### Maundy Thursday

We will celebrate Maundy Thursday at 7:00 pm on March 28. We have invited Dimondale to join us.

On the first Maundy Thursday, the night Jesus was to be arrested, he gathered with his disciples in an upper room to celebrate the Passover. Every year religious people celebrated the Passover, which reminded them of God delivering them from slavery in Egypt and leading them to the Promised Land. This meal, called the Seder, included specific foods that served as reminders of what God had done in the past. They dipped parsley or celery in salt water to remind them of God's promise of new life in the Promised Land and the tears they cried during slavery. They ate unleavened bread to remind them that their ancestors had fled in such haste that they didn't take time to allow the bread to rise before baking it. Jesus gathered with the disciples that night to remember God's deliverance from slavery in Egypt into the Promised Land,

Jesus added to the meal and transformed it into what we remember on Maundy Thursday. He lifted the bread as a reminder of his body, which he would give for us on the cross the next day. He shared the cup as a reminder of the new covenant that would be made through the spilling of his blood during the crucifixion.

When we gather on Maundy Thursday this year, we will remember. We will remember God's deliverance from slavery in Egypt and from sin and death. Join us as we share in the Lord's Supper and remember.

#### **Good Friday**

We have been invited to share in Good Friday worship at First Presbyterian Church of Dimondale at 7:00 pm on March 29. On Good Friday, we remember Jesus' suffering and death on the cross. We are reminded of his suffering and death as we await the Good News of Easter morning.

#### Easter Breakfast

Again this year we will have a Continental Breakfast before the Easter worship service. We will have various pastries, fruit, juice, coffee, tea, and water. The breakfast will begin at 9:15 am. Thank you to the Deacons and Spiritual Life Committee for providing the food.



#### Easter

Join us as we celebrate Easter at 10:00 am on Sunday, March 31. We will have food and fellowship prior to the service (9:15 am). We will celebrate Christ's triumph over death with butterflies and by flowering a cross. Join us as we celebrate the most important day of the Christian year.
