# **Daily Devotions** & Scriptures

### Monday, July 25 Read Job 1:13-22 & Proverbs 9:10

Most of us recoil somewhat at the story of Job and his divine testing. It is, we protest, manifestly unfair and cruel and no amount of rationalization can change that. Look closely at v.21. What is the fundamental truth about existence does Job proclaim? Where do we get the right or authority to declare what is "fair" or "unfair?" In this context, what does the verse from Proverbs mean?

#### Tuesday, July 26 Read Genesis 22:1-18

This story often causes readers difficulty and there is really no way to make it easier. It also shows us the seriousness with which God takes our faith and devotion and it should strike us with fear or at least caution. How much of our faith (or your personal faith) is contingent on God doing what you want or expect? Where do you say "no" to God and why? Discuss this with God in prayer today.

### Wednesday, July 27 Read John 3:16-17 & Romans 5:8

Abraham's willingness to offer his son was manifest proof of his devotion to God. In the well-known passage from John, we are told of God's devotion to humanity. Notice that humanity has done nothing to earn such devotion! Why is really understanding that truth essential to being a Christian? How does it affect the way you interact with others and why?

#### Thursday, July 28 Read Romans 6:12-23

Truthfully, we will either serve God or the broken elements of this world, namely, sin or selfishness. The other sad truth is that we are so separated from God by sin we cannot either work hard enough to be good enough or even offer enough. Hence our helplessness under the law. What do vv.21-22 mean to you? What does such "enslavement" look like in your daily life?

#### Friday, July 29 Read Hebrews 9:1-15

This is a very complex passage so read it through a few times. In essence we are reminded that all the sacrifices and any actions we do are only symbols or tokens of the devotion we would like to be able to offer (v.9) to God. None of holds the fullness of sacrifice that Abraham was asked for and that only Jesus could truly offer. Think of things that truly matter to you reflect on why sacrifice is essential to devotion. What tokens or symbols of thanksgiving do you offer as sacrifice for what God has done? What is the true heart, or motivation, behind such offerings?

#### Saturday, July 30 Read Psalm 13

In our times of darkness and doubt God is present, even when we have trouble seeing Him. What gives the psalmist hope in vv.5-6? What helps you cling to God in challenging times? How can you help others hang on?
