

## **Daily Devotions** & Scriptures

### Monday, June 13 Read Psalm 51

Why does David, as he repents from his awful sins with Bathsheba (2) Samuel 11), say he has sinned against God and God alone? What does this tell you about sin and about human nature?

### Tuesday, June 14 Read Jeremiah 2:1-37

Of what does Israel need to repent here and why? Jeremiah is of course speaking to the nation of Israel, but how is its sin similar to our own personal sins? If sin is seen as a rejection of God's presence and authority as opposed to certain bad acts, how might that shape our understanding of our own sinful nature?

### Wednesday, June 15 Read Genesis 3:1-14

We often hear the old adage, "the devil made me do it." In this story of the first sin, what exactly did the devil (or serpent) make Adam and Eve do? More realistically, what present desire did the serpent play on? How do you understand temptation in your own life?

### Thursday, June 16 Read John 9:1-41

This story is framed as a clever commentary on sin. In the ancient world, physical ailments were seen as proof of spiritual or religious failure. Yet it is the 'good and righteous' Pharisees who are the truly blind ones here. In what way are they blind? What does this tell you about how God sees sin and brokenness?

### Friday, June 27 Read Romans 1:18-32

In your own words, how does Paul sum up the human condition here? Why are things in this world so broken and off kilter? How can things be set aright? Share a prayer of personal confession with God today.

#### Saturday, June 18 Read 1 John 1:5-10

Why is it dangerous to think we have not sinned? How is sin a condition (given all your readings this week) rather than simply some bad actions? Does that matter? Why or why not?
