1. God expects the <u>best</u> we have, re- gardless of what we think <u>others</u> are <u>doing</u> .	<b>4:2-10</b> It's hard to see why God rejected Cain's offering but the clue may be in Cain's bringing of <i>an</i> offering and Abel's offering of his <i>firstlings</i> . Tradition holds that Abel gave his best while Cain gave what he could spare. Either way, why did Cain take out his anger on his brother?
<u>2. Jealousy</u> and <u>anger</u> will control us if we don't control them.	What does this tell us about our refusal to take responsibility for ourselves?



# "BROTHERLY LOVE?"

#### Thursday, June 23 Read Mark 10:17-27

Note that the man's confidence is rooted in his own ability to keep the commandments and 'be good,' rather than in faith in God. If Jesus is not calling everyone to give up all possessions what is his point in telling the man to do it?

What would He say you need to remove in order to increase your trust in God?

## Friday, June 24 Read Hebrews 11:1-16

Based on this explanation from Hebrews, what is your own definition of faith?

List some of the ways your own life bears tangible witness to your faith and trust in God.

Discuss this with God in prayer today and listen closely for His answer.

### Saturday, June 25 Read James 3:4-14

Our lives have impact on others, whether we intend to or not. Our words and our actions have consequences, often far beyond what we can immediately see.
