Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday – Matthew 27:22

Read Matthew 27:22. Pilate's question, "What shall I do with Jesus?" is one every person must answer. It's not just a historical moment, it's a daily decision. To live the Gospel means we don't stay neutral; we actively choose to follow and submit to Christ. Every day presents opportunities to respond to Jesus with our lives. What does your daily life say about your answer to Pilate's question? In what area of your life do you need to more clearly choose Jesus?

Tuesday – John 18:38

Read John 18:38. When Pilate asks, "What is truth?" he stands face-to-face with Jesus, the Truth Himself, and still misses it. Living the Gospel means more than asking questions; it means embracing the truth of who Jesus is. Truth is not just something we know, it's Someone we follow. Our lives should reflect that we have found and surrendered to that truth. Are you treating truth as an idea, or as a person to follow? How can your actions this week reflect the truth of Christ?

Wednesday – John 15:5-11

Read John 15:5-11. Jesus reminds us that apart from Him, we can do nothing. Living the Gospel is not about trying harder but abiding deeper. When we remain in Christ, our lives naturally produce fruit that reflects Him. Joy, obedience, and love flow from a life connected to Jesus. What does it look like for you to "abide" in Christ daily? Are you relying more on your effort or your connection to Jesus?

Thursday – Galatians 3:10-12

Read Galatians 3:10-12. The law shows us that we can't earn righteousness on our own. Living the Gospel means rejecting the idea that we can be "good enough" and instead trusting fully in Christ. We don't live for approval, we live from approval already given through Jesus. Grace, not works, is our foundation. Do you ever find yourself trying to earn God's approval? How can you rest more fully in the finished work of Christ?

Friday – Micah 6:6-8

Read Micah 6:6-8. God doesn't desire empty religious actions; He desires transformed lives. To live the Gospel is to act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with Him. These are not burdens but evidence of a heart changed by grace. The Gospel lived out is visible in how we treat others and walk with God. Which of these, justice, mercy, or humility do you need to grow in most? How can you intentionally live out your faith in a practical way today?

Saturday – Hebrews 6:11-12

Read Hebrews 6:11-12. The Christian life is not a sprint but a steady race of faith and endurance. Living the Gospel means staying diligent and not growing complacent. We follow the example of those who trusted God's promises and remained faithful. Perseverance is a powerful testimony of a life rooted in the Gospel. Where are you tempted to lose passion or consistency in your faith? How can you remain faithful and finish strong in your walk with Christ?
