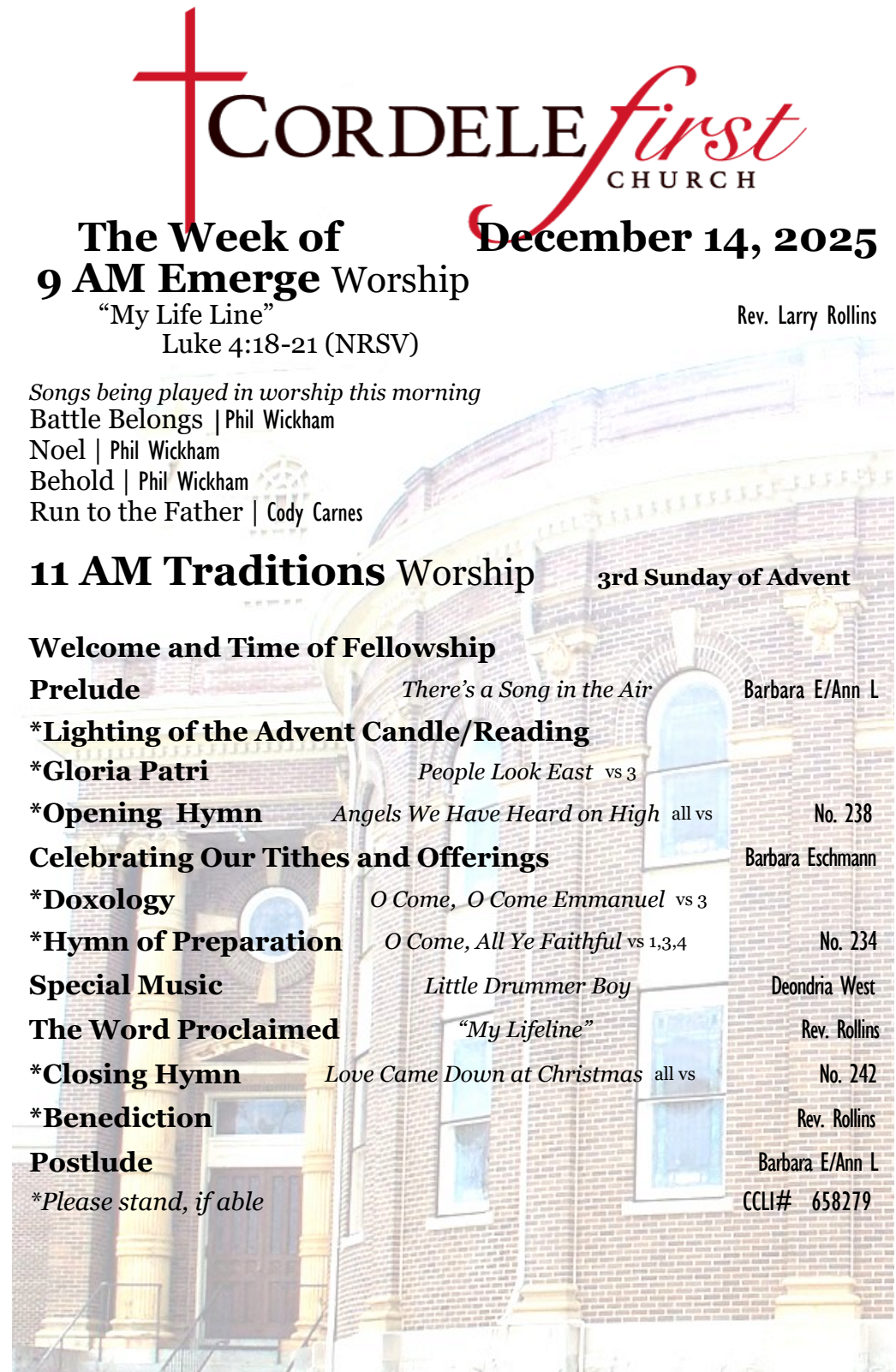

Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, December 15 Read Psalm 146:5-10

What does this psalm explain about the nature of God? What might this say about God’s relationship to you and your life? Reflect on some ways your relationship with God creates joy and happiness in your life. Take a moment to discuss these with God in thanksgiving.

Tuesday December 16 Read Isaiah 35:1-10

Isaiah’s images here are those of resurrection and renewal- the desert turned from wasteland to brimming life. The joy of complete rejuvenation and abundant living is one of the most wonderful gifts of the Messiah-Jesus-whom this passage describes. How has Christ brought rejuvenation to your life? Where are you still needing that?

Wednesday, December 17 Read Luke 1:46-55

Mary’s song here is a celebration of God’s regard for his people, especially the lowly or the seemingly unimportant. During this Advent season, how can we communicate that good news of which Mary sings? What does this song mean for you personally?

Thursday, December 18 Read Matthew 11:2-11

In his dark moment, John the Baptist begins to doubt himself and his message. Jesus’ response is to show him the promise was even at that moment being fulfilled. Are there times when you doubt or question the purpose of your faith? What can change those doubts? In what ways can we open our eyes anew to see what God is indeed doing?

Friday, December 19 Read James 5:7-10

It is very hard for us to wait for much of anything. Yet waiting makes us pay attention, look harder and lean on God. What are some ways we can strengthen ourselves and one another as we live in this time of waiting for God’s ultimate plan to unfold? What should we be doing in this period and how should we be doing it?

Saturday, December 20 Read Psalm 126

Just take the time to visualize the joyous images of renewed hope and possibility the psalmist celebrates here. What are some ways we live and show the joy we experience in God? Be as specific as possible.
