

Monday, December 22 Read Psalm 100

Try memorizing this psalm (or write it down on a small card) and recite it as a prayer throughout the day. In what ways does it shape your perspectives and the way you live today? Discuss this experience with God in prayer.

Tuesday, December 23 Read Isaiah 9:2-7

Look closely at v.6. What are some of the ways Jesus lives into these roles and titles in your daily faith experience? Where do you need Him to be more of one or the other? Why? Reflect on how you let Jesus be these things in your life.

Wednesday December 24 Read Luke 2:1-20

Read this familiar story aloud, preferably with family and friends if possible. If possible, discuss what parts are your favorites and listen for what others find to be the best part of this story. To ponder: What does the nativity story tell you about just who God is?

Thursday, December 25 Read John 1:1-14

If you are gathering for a Christmas dinner today, read this as part of the blessing of the meal. Remember, the babe in the manger is just a part of the story. That baby is the very power of God made human and sent to live, love, serve and die among us. How does that add impact to the story of Jesus' birth?

Friday, December 26 Read Titus 2:11-14

For us Christians it is important to remember that the gift at Bethlehem was just the first stage of God's unfolding plan. What does Titus say the coming of Jesus and His subsequent sacrifice have done and continue to do for us? How are we shaped by Him and for what are we waiting?

Saturday, December 27 Read Psalm 96

Read this psalm through a few times as your personal prayer and declaration. What would it look like if you were to do what the psalmist calls us to do? Give some specific examples. How will you live into this promise in the new year? Discuss it with God in prayer today.
