Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, April 6 Read Psalm 114

When we celebrate Easter, we proclaim the God who stands beyond time, over death and without limitations. Savor the poetic language of this psalm and reflect on what it tells you about God. How has God shown His presence and power to you? How do such experiences shape you?

Tuesday, April 7 Read Isaiah 25:6-9

This week we reflect on the meaning of salvation. In Christ we find our meaning and purpose and are freed from pointless and brief living to relationship with God and the promise of eternity. If Easter begins to usher in the promise of this prophecy, how should it affect the way you live from this day on?

Wednesday, April 8 Read 1 Corinthians 5:6-8

Easter can be understood as a clean slate, justification and redemption purchased on the cross. If so, what is the 'old yeast' that's needs to be tossed from your life and what new yeast will replace it?

Thursday, April 9 Read Luke 24:13-29

Notice that the disciples only recognize Jesus through interaction with him in daily, mundane activities (walking, talking and sharing a meal). Too often we reserve our interactions with Jesus for special times, like in church. How can Jesus be more a part of your daily activities? Discuss this with God in prayer today.

Friday, April 10 Read Acts 10:34-43

Peter fulfills Jesus' command to tell everyone what he has seen and what he has experienced. Many of us are intimidated by the idea of witnessing, thinking we're required to be great theologians. If, however, you have tasted and seen that the Lord is good (Psalm 34), it should be easy to share your experiences. Also, it is ours to invite and share, not to convince or save! Who have you shared your faith with?

Saturday, April 11 Read Psalm 118:1-2;14-24

Read this slowly as your own personal prayer. What adjustments to these words would make it speak more directly to your situation? Read it again and listen for what God is saying to you through His Word.
