# **Daily Devotions** & Scriptures

# Monday, January 22 Read Psalm 59:16-17

This is one of the royal psalms praying for deliverance from enemies, yet it is built upon the confident knowledge of God's abiding love. How does the knowledge of another's love provide strength and confidence for you? How does knowing God loves you give you courage and hope for living?

### Tuesday January 23 Read Deuteronomy 6:1-9

We are familiar with the call to love the Lord (Jesus echoed it in Matthew 22). Why is the scripture so insistent that we teach this fact repeatedly and write it down? Given the subsequent history of the people of Israel and our own experience of discipleship, why is this repetition good advice and what does it say about our tendency to fall away?

## Wednesday, January 24 Read Micah 6:1-8

The motivation for doing good is the response of a loving and grateful heart to all that God has done and will do. Since we cannot pay that back, what does God expect from you? Reflect on some specific ways you are being called to live out v.8?

# Thursday, January 25 Read Romans 5:1-8

Our faith is rooted in a recognition that we have done nothing, and can do nothing, to earn our own salvation. Indeed, any good we do is a response to God's love and a gracious action from the Holy Spirit. Why is recognizing our own sinfulness the first step to living Christ-like lives? What, in practical and relational terms, does recognizing our own sinfulness look like?

## Friday, January 26 Read Luke 22:14-20

Love is an expression of sharing all we are with another. In what ways does the celebration of communion re-enact or re-member the love of God expressed in Christ? How can a deeper appreciation for this sacrament help us stay in love with God?

## Saturday, January 27 Read 1 John 3:17-24

We are called to 'walk the walk' not merely 'talk the talk.' John tells us that God's very nature is love so why then is loving others so vital to our Christian faith?
