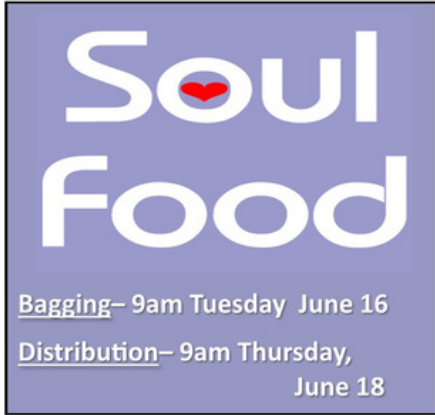


News & Events

Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, June 15 Read Psalm 34

The psalmist here offers ways we can “taste” God’s goodness and be content and at peace. What activities and goals can help us experience such peace? Look closely at vv.11-14. While God’s Spirit does indeed bring peace, what are we called to do in order to receive that Spiritual gift?

Tuesday June 16 Read Isiah 32:9-20

The word “righteousness” simply means to be on the right and best path. What right path, or direction, is Isaiah calling for here? What might v.17 mean in real, practical terms and what might it mean, specifically, for your own life? How does such righteousness bring peace?

Wednesday, June 17 Read John 14:1-31

Jesus knows his disciples are about to experience an extremely un-peaceful time! How is the transcendent peace He offers tied to his reminders in vv.6, 15, 21 & 26? Is there a common thread here in how we can access the fruit that is the Holy Spirit’s peace? How does this passage offer peace in your life?

Thursday, June 18 Read Philippians 4:1-9

Like the joy we explored last week, God’s gift of peace is tightly tied to maintaining our connection to God and our course on His path. It can be likened to being on an enjoyable and comfortable journey as long as you know where you are going and that you are on the correct route. What are some aspects of this “correct route” that Paul touches on here (see vv.4,5 & 8 especially)?

Friday, June 19 Read Matthew 11:25-30

Note that the promise of rest, or peace, that Jesus gives at v.28 is built on a recognition of God’s ultimate control and the necessary trust of the disciple. Honestly reflect on how much stress you cause yourself by maintaining control. What are things you have trouble letting go of and why? How is relinquishing control to God different from doing nothing or being simply passive (reflect a bit on some earlier readings from this week)?

Saturday, June 20 Read 1 Peter 3:8-18

Godly peace is also tied to a proper attitude as regards relationships and this chapter has, at its core, a goal of household unity. If we keep the great commandment in mind (love God, love neighbor) how is seeking peace an integral part of God’s plan for His disciples? How are vv.9,11 & 15 connected and what do they tell us about our own priorities and being at peace with God’s Will? Note the quotes in vv.10-12 from Psalm 34.
