Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, June 22 Read Psalm 40:1-8

What is the result of David's patience here? How is trust in God an essential part of cultivating patience? Read vv.6-8 through a few times. What is it that God is ultimately desiring from us? Note that the outward rituals (sacrifices and burnt offerings) are not themselves the goal here. How can patience and trust be seen as sacrificial? If so, what is being sacrificed?

Tuesday June 23 Read Ecclesiastes 7:1-14

Running through these pithy aphorisms is a reminder to see the big, eternal picture. We are often tempted to take short-cuts to what we think will be a good life and in so doing we become corrupt, irritable, intolerant and lose sight of God's plans. Look at v.8. Why is patience seen as the opposite of pride? What does this tell us about human nature?

Wednesday, June 24 Read Hebrews 12:1-12

When reflecting on the running metaphor in v.1, why is perseverance (or patience) essential for any meaningful task? The writer of Hebrews also equates patience with discipline and quotes a version of Proverbs 32 (vv.5-6) to encourage us to see a larger purpose behind challenges. How does this change if we think of discipline as structure and purposeful focus rather than punishment? How does anything meaningful or productive require discipline? Why should discipleship be any different?

Thursday, June 25 Read 2 Timothy 4:1-5

While patience is good for any number of situations, the Spirit-gifted patience is focused on fulfilling God's mission and as noted here, that often meets stubborn resistance. Look closely at v.2. How often do we balk at doing the work of the church because challenges convince us the season is "unfavorable." In a sinful world, won't it always be? What is your personal "work of an evangelist (v.5)?"

Friday, June 26 Read James 1:2-12

How are endurance and patience (vv.3-4) the same? It's hard to consider having to endure anything to be a joyful experience so what does James mean here? What can make us grateful for having to have patience? What roles does humility (or the lack of it) play in being a patient person?

Saturday, June 27 Read Galatians 6:1-10

Sometimes we lack patience with someone who is not doing what we would do, or they are not doing it the way we would. What does this passage say to that sort of mindset? The word often translated as "patience" is often rightly rendered as "forbearance," meaning refraining from doing what we are tempted to do. How does v. 9 understand the role of Christian forbearance?

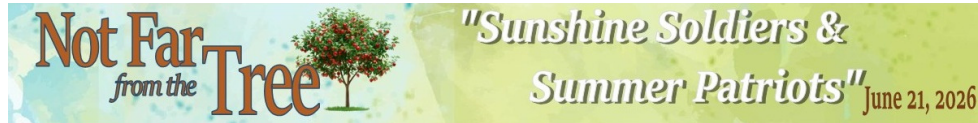
