Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, June 29 Read Psalm 36:1-12

This beautiful psalm declares powerfully the difference between God and human beings. What does it say about the nature of God and what He values? What does it tell us about the nature of human beings? How is this difference the vital key in the relationship between God and humanity?

Tuesday June 30 Read Deuteronomy 7:7-9

The foundational truth about God's people is found in their insignificance. Neither numerous nor powerful, Israel was chosen purely by the grace of God. Being aware of this unmerited grace is supposed to provoke a response (see v.9) and shape how we deal with others who we might see as inferior or undeserving. Reread this passage but think of it as speaking about you, personally. How might this truth shape you and your actions?

Wednesday, July 1 Read Luke 6:27-36

Kindness is a form of mercy, giving love and care to someone who has not earned or deserved it. Given what Jesus says here, how is kindness more than just being polite to the people around us or simply not giving offense? In this context, what does it mean to be children of God (v.35)?

Thursday, July 2 Read Titus 3:1-7

It is important to understand that God's goodness comes solely from His loving and merciful nature, not from any sense of deserving. Indeed, it comes in spite of the fact that none of us deserves it! Also notice that in v. 5 this is the work of the Holy Spirit, the same Spirit that fills us (v.6). In what ways then does the Spirit re-mind us about practicing kindness?

Friday, July 3 Read Ephesians 4:1-3;25-32

In what ways can the adjectives in v.2 be seen as putting kindness into actual practice? According to the next verse, what is the Spirit's ultimate purpose for giving us this capacity for kindness? Vv. 25-32 are more concrete aspects of practicing Christian kindness. How is this different from what the rest of the world often calls "kindness?" Try memorizing and praying over v.32 throughout the day today.

Saturday, July 4 Read Colossians 3:12-17

John Wesley referred to this passage as "the perfect compendium and descriptor of the disciple truly surrendered to Christ." After reading this do you agree with him? If so, what about this reflects your own experience as a disciple and where might it point out areas of growth for you? Discuss this with God in prayer today and be sure to listen for God's response.
