Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, June 30 Read Hebrews 10:23-25 The author of Hebrews wants his audience to focus on and understand faith, perseverance, and the new covenant they have in Christ. These are all key to discipleship. Discipleship doesn't just happen. What have you been doing to cultivate deep, honest, relationships in which you do spiritual good to other Christians? What does it mean to spur each other on in Christ-likeness?

Tuesday, July 1 Read 2 Corinthians 4:5-15 Paul is addressing a church body that has been a poor representation of Christ. Not only are they living in a very ungodly manner, they are arguing about who is in charge and who is the "highest" amongst their group. Paul is trying to turn their attention back to Christ and His accomplishments. We have the most important message of all time, the message of salvation and God has entrusted it with us. All that we do for God is because He has allowed us to do it. In what ways is God allowing you to serve Him? In what ways is God allowing you to serve His church? What have you done with that valuable message lately?

Wednesday, July 2 Read 2 Timothy 2:1-3 Paul is instructing Timothy on how to make sure the church in Ephesus was healthy and building up the body of believers through discipleship. Good disciples help other believers grow in their Christ-likeness. We are to intentionally pour into others so that they can pour into others. What am I doing to build up my family into the image of Christ? How can I pour into other believers around me? What would my Sunday School class look like if we all poured into other believers?

Thursday, July 3 Read 1 John 2:3-6 Obedience to God's commands is a sure-fire sign of our spiritual health. Theologian J.C. Ryle said, "Praying and sinning will never live together in the same heart. Prayer will consume sin, or sin will choke prayer." Jesus Christ modeled obedience to the Father through His own life. We cannot bear fruit without obedience. What fruit are you currently bearing in your life? How big is prayer in your life? What can others pray for you about?

Friday, July 4 Read 2 Corinthians 5:17-21 When we encounter Jesus, we meet a man who has called us to come and die. In His call for us to follow and learn from Him we are required to repent of rebelling against our creator and to cling to Him through faith. If we do this, we are promised forgiveness of our sins and reconciliation to God. We are called to come and die so that we might live. What has your faith done for you this week? In what ways does your faith impact your daily life and choices?

Saturday, July 5 Read Matthew 28:19-20 This is the Great Commission, Jesus' final marching orders to all believers. We are called to be disciples of Christ by spending time with the Father, learning His Word, putting Christ above ourselves, living in Christian community, bearing fruit, but we are not true disciples if we do not replicate ourselves. The Great Commission is not an encouragement, but a command to go out to the lost and broken world and share the hope of Christ. We are to proclaim the good news of Christ by teaching about Him and calling others to repentance and belief. What am I doing to live out the Great Commission? What has Christ done in my life that I can share with others?
