Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, June 8 Read Psalm 16

We are often schooled to think of boundary lines (v.6) as negatives, as restrictions or limitations on our freedom. Why then does the psalmist speak of them so positively and actually find joy (v.9) in them? What might this tell us about the role of God and of faith in experiencing joy and fulfillment? How do we explain such a paradox?

Tuesday June 9 Read Habakkuk 3:1-19

What gives the prophet joy (“yet I will rejoice...”, vv.18-19) despite all the terrifying and ominous pronouncements that have come before? Are there times in your life you find joy and contentment despite circumstances? How? What does this passage tell us about the difference between joy and simple emotionalism?

Wednesday, June 10 Read Luke 2:8-19

The angel promises great joy to humanity. There are a number of words for happiness that Luke could have used here but he chose chara (χαράν) which has the same root as grace, gift and spirit. Given the context of this nativity story, why is this use of the term (often translated ‘joy’) appropriate? What does this say to you about the coming of Christ, not just to Bethlehem, but also into our hearts?

Thursday, June 11 Read Romans 15:5-13

This passage is structured around a call to unity, first between Jews and Gentiles, but as a larger understanding that we have been brought together by God for God’s purposes and as a fellowship empowered by His Holy Spirit. How is true joy and contentment as disciples fostered by unity and fellowship? How does our cultural drive for individualism at times undercut this joy?

Friday, June 12 Read Philippians 1:3-19

In the midst of imprisonment and persecution, Paul writes a wonderfully joyous letter. Though the circumstances are not good, what gives Paul joy here (list some specific examples). Ultimately, on what goal is he focusing? What does that tell us about our own priorities, contentment and joy in our personal discipleship? Discuss this with God in prayer today.

Saturday, June 13 James 1:2-17

The use of the word joy here cannot mean happiness as we generally understand it. Look closely at vv.1-2; 12 & 17. What is the joy we are being promised here and what accounts for it? How is it different from the mere feeling of happiness? Have you experienced such joy? Why or why not?
