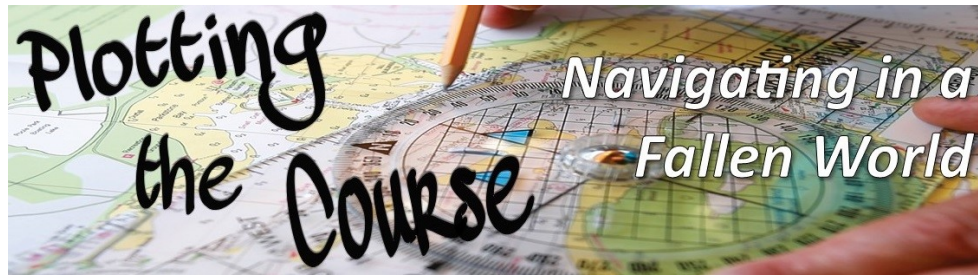

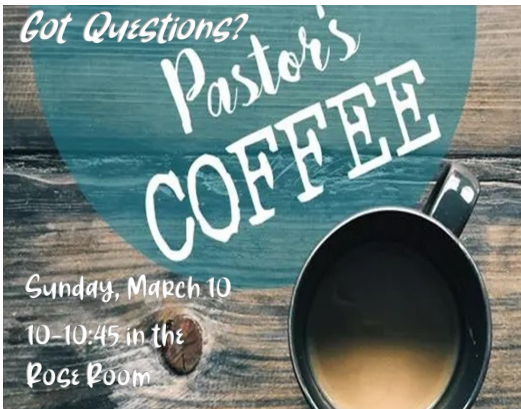

Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, March 11 Read Numbers 21:4-9

The Israelites didn't have to do anything special such as make a sacrifice, pay money, or even say a prayer, they just had to simply look and have faith in God. Do you think the Israelites had to be convinced to just simply look and have faith? What stops many of us today from looking and having faith?

Tuesday, March 12 Read Psalm 13

Despite how terrible David felt in the beginning of this Psalm, he still trusts God. There are many things that challenge our resolve and give us anxiety. David still has faith, just as we should still have faith. Who are some people in your life that have shown great faith? How can you ask God to help you to show faith?

Wednesday, March 13 Read John 7:32-53

The Pharisees are once again angered that Jesus is claiming His deity. They refused to believe Him and even wanted Him arrested, but the temple police were too astounded by Him. We also see Nicodemus for a second time. What do you think Nicodemus was risking by defending Jesus here? Are there situations where you can stick your neck out and talk about Jesus with someone?

Thursday, March 14 Read Matthew 7:13-14

Jesus is warning the people that only a few will follow Him and have eternal life. Many will stay in the wrong path and completely miss the narrow trail. Who are some people that have helped show and keep you on the narrow path? What are some markers or blazes that have kept you on the path?

Friday, March 15 Read John 19:38-42

We have the third and final appearance of Nicodemus in the Bible. He has gone from the curious man who sought Jesus under the cover of darkness, to the man who begins to stand up for Him, to the man risking it all to honor Him. Has your faith journey seen similar steps? Where would you say you are on your journey?

Saturday, March 16 Read Matthew 5:13-16

Once we begin to follow Jesus, our sins are brought into the light and can be seen. Not by God, He has always known our sins, but by us. As disciples, our sins should now bother us and we should seek to discover and pursue Him as much as we can. And this includes eliminating what separates us. What parts of you are still clinging to the dark? Do you have an accountability partner or group that you can open up about your sins to?
