Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, March 2 Read Psalm 105:1-6;16-22

We have some challenging readings ahead of us this week, so take some time to re-read and savor this beautiful psalm. What does it say to us (not simply the ancient Israelites) about God? In what ways does your own experience and witness confirm the praise and promises lifted here? Can you rewrite this psalm in a way that tells your own story with God?

Tuesday, March 3 Read 1 Kings 19:9-18

In this familiar story, why does God choose to appear to Elijah in "sheer silence" rather than in some other, more dramatic, form? What sort of mood and mind-set is Elijah in that blocks his awareness of God and Elijah's own purpose? What does this say about your own discipleship? What unlikely form does God use to reach you?

Wednesday, March 4 Read Matthew 8:23-27

Our gospel reading from last Sunday (and tomorrow's devotion) is not the first time Jesus has shown his power over nature and His divine identity. What do vv.25-26 say about the nature of our faith and the sort of relationship we are called to grow into? Are the disciples truly puzzled in v.27 or are they simply unwilling to accept the ramifications of the truth? Why?

Thursday, March 5 Read Matthew 14:22-33

Peter's actions here are an uncomfortably normal mix of faith, doubt and hope. Note that Jesus identified himself (v.27) but Peter needs to test that truth in v.28 (not unlike the high priest in 26:63, the mockers at the cross in 27:40 or even Satan himself in 4:3 & 6!). Why does Jesus accept Peter's challenge here? How is Peter's cry in v.30 both the core of this story and the core of true discipleship?

Friday, March 6 Read Romans 10:5-15

The "word" here in v.8 is logos, the same term used in John 1:1-5 for the very presence and power of God in Christ. Reflect on this passage in light of the two storm stories from previous devotions. What is the nature of faith that Paul is describing here? How is it different from mere belief? What does v. 10 mean in modern, practical terms?

Saturday, March 7 Read Psalm 85:8-13

In the midst of this beautiful, poetic language, what does it mean to you for God to "speak peace to His people" and that "steadfast love and faithfulness will meet; righteousness and peace will kiss each other." Avoid cliched answers here! What is God promising to you and how can you live into that promise?
