

Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, March 23 Read Psalm 121

We often say "in God we trust" (a variation of v.2) but, truthfully, God is often our last resort after everything we try on our own fails. Why do you think that is? How would your outlook and faith practices change if you truly trusted God's way and process from the beginning? What would you have to change in your life in order to do this?

Tuesday, March 24 Read Genesis 12:1-4

How would you describe Abram's faith in this passage? Note the connection between listening to God (v.1) and responding completely (v.4). What has to happen in our hearts and minds before we can make this connection? How is God calling you today and in what ways are you responding?

Wednesday, March 25 Read Matthew 17:1-9

In the presence of the glory of God, Peter seems to have an urge to do something...even if it is just building shelters that are not needed! Is this symptomatic of our urge to be in control over everything? Why or why not? What is the significance of v.5 in applying this story to our own discipleship?

Thursday, March 26 Read Romans 4:1-5;13-17

The faith of Abraham (which you read about on Tuesday) is clearly not about him working to be good enough for God, i.e. not based on works. Yet that does not mean that faith isn't embodied in some physical or attitudinal manifestation. How would you explain Paul's argument here to someone unfamiliar with the Christian faith?

Friday, March 27 Read John 3:1-17

Nicodemus is in a conundrum. His traditions, customs and peers urge him to reject the radical prophet from Nazareth but his own heart, mind and spirit tell him that there is something profoundly right about Jesus (v.2). In what ways do we still struggle with this dilemma? How do you struggle? In light of this conflict and Jesus' words, what do you think it means to be "born again?"

Saturday, March 28 Read Mark 8:31-38

In light of your readings this week, what do vv.34-37 mean for a modern Christian disciple? What does it look like for you to "lose your life" for Christ and how is God calling you to make that sacrifice? Discuss this with God in prayer today and listen closely for His answer.
