



Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, April 1 Read Psalm 118:1-2;14-24

Easter defines us as Christians. As you read this psalm of victory and faith, reflect on the meaning of the good news of Easter for your life. How does your experience with the risen Lord shape your goals and priorities, as well as your concerns and challenges for today? What does it mean for you to live victoriously?

Tuesday, April 2 Read Isaiah 25:6-9

If the finality of death and the fear of Hell has been taken away, what do we have to worry about? Yet so many Christians live as if they are scared to death! Why? How can we claim the freedom and good news that Isaiah here proclaims?

Wednesday, April 3 Read Luke 24:13-49

Like the disciples on the road that evening, most of us have trouble recognizing God at work when He works outside of our familiar areas or comfort zones. What does this mind-set tell us about ourselves and the weakness of our discipleship? Where have you encountered God in unexpected areas or ways? How can we be more open to *whatever* God has planned?

Thursday, April 4 Read Acts 10:34-43

Like Peter, what experiences do you have with Jesus that make up your own personal witness? Take some time to reflect on the ways Christ has worked in your life. How can you share this as an encouragement to others? Discuss this with God in prayer today.

Friday, April 5 Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

Take some time to reflect on vv.1-2 in particular. What does this section mean to you personally? In what ways is the truth of Christ saving you today? Knowing that our sins are forgiven, that we are recipients of an amazing grace and that the one who saves us is here with us should shape how we face each day and deal with each person. What difference does the Good News make in your life today?

Saturday, April 6 Read Psalm 114

When we deal with familiar stories and scriptures we are sometimes in danger of missing its power and impact. This psalm reminds us of who God is and who we are in Him. How does the Easter story do the same thing? Take a moment to share a prayer of thanksgiving and dedication to God.
