Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, June 1 Read Psalm 40

The first verse of this psalm is probably the hardest part about faith. Waiting is so difficult, especially when we feel we are struggling and in need of help. We want God to act now, on our timetable. The psalmist here reminds us that God will strengthen us and answer our prayers... though not necessarily in the way we think He should! What comforts does this psalm give you personally? How?

Tuesday June 2 Read Nehemiah 1:1-11

What caused Nehemiah to make the radical life change he did? What are some of the ways God opened doors for him to do this? What burdens, goals or challenges is God putting on you and on your discipleship? How are you responding? Do you trust that God will open necessary doors? Why or why not?

Wednesday, June 3 Read Matthew 9:35-38

"Compassion (v.36)" means with passion, zeal or energy. It is a driving call not simply a passing emotion. How is God kindling a passion for His Kingdom work in you? If you don't have such a pull, why do you think that is? What do you have passion about and why? Discuss this with God in prayer today.

Thursday, June 4 Read 2 Corinthians 4:1-12

We often decline challenges because we don't feel we are equipped or ready for them or they are simply too big. How does Paul address such fears here in regards to living out our disciple-making commission? what encourages or drives you to do this? What holds you back?

Friday, June 5 Read Nehemiah 2:1-20

Note how elaborate and secret are Nehemiah's activities and the negative response from Sanballat and Tobiah. Even the best purposes will have detractors and opponents. What gives Nehemiah strength to face them down? What gives you strength in the face of opposition?

Saturday, June 6 Read Psalm 37:1-9;23-24

Once again we re-visit the themes of patience and promise. Why is it so important that God keep reminding us of this? what does this say about us? About God? What does this tell us about the struggle and even failures we face?

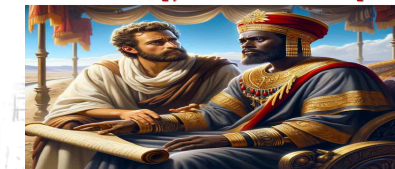
