Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, November 17 Read Psalm 100

Read this through a few times today as your own personal song of praise and thanksgiving, then meditate a bit on v.3. What does to mean to you to *know* that the Lord is God? Is that phrase simply redundant or is the psalmist trying to awaken us to a deeper truth about ourselves and our faith? Why does the psalmist call us to “make a joyful noise” and what would such an action look like for you today?

Tuesday, November 18 Read Ezekiel 34:11-16; 20-24

God’s compassion for the broken and lost did not begin with Jesus. The ultimate reminder is that we are to treat others as God’s priceless children for whom He seeks, cares for and ultimately saves. Look closely at vv.16 and vv.20-22. What does this tell you about God? What does it tell us about humanity and what God expects from our relationship with Him?

Wednesday, November 19 Matthew 25:31-40

It’s important to remember that we are not charged to care for the lost and least in order to earn credit with God. Such selflessness is the way we are to embody Christ, making areal difference by furthering the mission of building the Kingdom and saving the lost. Right now and in what way, where is God leading you to impact the lives around you?

Thursday, November 20 Read Matthew 5:1-20

Those who follow Christ are to set a different standard for the world and a very noticeable one at that. How do verses 1-11 relate to or explain what we are called to do and be in vv. 10-16?

Friday, November 21 Read James 2:8-20

The dispute over faith v. works unfortunately revolves around what it takes to get into heaven rather than a reflection on our purpose and the nature of a life lived in relationship with Christ. What is James saying here about the nature of discipleship, belief and living for God? What is this passage saying about your own discipleship? Discuss it with God in prayer today.

Saturday, November 22 Read Psalm 97:1-7

As this psalm celebrates the power and authority of God, what does v.7 warn us about? What “images” are we in the modern era guilty of serving and how might such service distract us or compete with the energies God expects us to use for His purposes?
