Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, November 10 Read Psalm 18

This is a marvelous song of trust and celebration. Read it through again and listen for the psalmist’s joy and reflect on what gives him such fulfillment and confidence. Try memorizing vv.28-30 and repeat them to yourself throughout the day. What ‘troop’ do you need to outrun and what ‘wall’ are you being called to leap over? How has God been with you in all of this?

Tuesday, November 11 Read 1 Samuel 16:1-13

David’s own father didn’t think he was capable of fulfilling what Samuel was looking for, but God knew the potential. Reflect a bit on v.7 and how it can refer to your own connection and service. How often do we limit ourselves or our expectations because we see only limitations and difficulties? How does real faith call us to transcend such doubts?

Wednesday, November 12 John 14:9-17

On Sunday, we read the Message version of this passage because that paraphrase emphasizes that Jesus is not promising to do *whatever* we want or give us *whatever* we like, but is promising to give us everything we need to do *His* work. Re-read this passage and reflect on what God is calling you to do for His Church and discuss your concerns and perceived limitations with Him in prayer today.

Thursday, November 13 Read Acts 9:19-31

The story of the church in Acts is full of unlikely, seemingly incapable people doing extraordinary things for God through the power and presence of the Holy Spirit. No one is more unlikely than that opponent of the church, Saul. As Jesus promised in John 14, Saul-Paul- did indeed do greater things. What might be the message in this for you?

Friday, November 14 Read Ephesians 2:4-10

So often we hesitate to serve or reach out because we feel we are ill equipped or unable to do the task. Re-read vv.8-10. How might Paul have responded to your own doubts and hesitations? According to v.10, why are any of us here in the first place? Discuss this with God in prayer today.

Saturday, November 15 Read Psalm 77

How does the psalmist here respond to those inevitable challenges and failures? What does this tell us about our own response in difficult times? What mighty deeds of God in your own life do you need to regularly call to mind (vv.11-12)?
