

Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, October 13 Read Psalm 66:1-12

At v.10 this psalm of praise seems to take a drastic turn. How are vv.10-12 also a song of praise? What is being celebrated and why? Does this reflect how you see and understand tests and trials? Why or why not?

Tuesday October 14 Read Jeremiah 29:1;4-7

In the midst of exile, the Israelites are instructed to both maintain hope and be a blessing to their captors. This is both a demonstration of their ultimate trust in God and a witness to the Babylonians. What does our response to the challenges of life say about our own dependence on God? How can we live in such a way as to be both blessings to others and witnesses to God?

Wednesday, October 15 Read Luke 17:11-19

So often we turn to God only when all of our efforts have failed. Worse we credit ourselves with skill, luck or cleverness and forget to see God at work and thank Him. Why does Luke point out the fact that the one grateful man was a Samaritan? What does this say about those who are supposed to be close to God? What might it suggest for us?

Thursday, October 16 Read 2 Timothy 2:8-15

V. 9 reminds us that while Paul's body may be hindered, the purpose for which he exists is not. If the goal of discipleship is not to have all our earthly desires met, what is it? How does looking beyond oneself increase both strength and positivity? How do we "keep our minds on Jesus (v.8) and why?"

Friday, October 17 Read 1 Peter 4:1-13

The Scripture is at great pains to draw a distinction between the flesh (earthly goals and values) and the eternal life of God. Such separation is painful (in Colossians 2: 11 Paul calls it the 'circumcision of the flesh"!) but necessary. Are there times that challenges and sufferings have helped you reprioritize and draw closer to God? Discuss your current challenges with Him in this context.

Saturday, October 18 Read Romans 5:1-8

Re-read vv.3-5. While we rarely think of trials and challenges as being good for us, what positive note about them is sounded here? Are there times you have experienced this truth in your own faith walk? How do we encourage people who are being tested or going through periods of doubt? What good news is available for them?
