Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, September 29 Read Psalm 91:1-6;14-16

What does this passage tell you about God? What does it say about the relationship God wants from human beings? What are some practical ways we can live in God’s shelter (v.1) and what does that mean for you as a modern Christian? What does it mean to “know (God’s) name (v.14)?”

Tuesday September 30 Read Jeremiah 32:1-3a;6-15

Jeremiah’s purchase of Hanamel’s field just as Jerusalem is about to fall to the Babylonians is a bold and public act of optimism and faith in God’s ultimate plan. True discipleship stands firm especially when the rest of the world says it is crazy or futile. Are there times your faith seems out of step or bigger than what the world says is important? If so, when? If not, why do you think that is?

Wednesday, October 1 Read Amos 6:1a;4-7

Our sinful tendency is to put our trust in ourselves and in what we can do or possess. We must push against this temptation or we will find ourselves the recipients of the bad new Amos gives here. Look closely at the last part of v.6. What *should* we be grieved over or, to put it another way, what should be the focus of our passion and our energy? Discuss this with God in prayer today.

Thursday, October 2 Read Luke 16:19-31

We fool ourselves when we short-sightedly act as if this present life is all there is and all that matters or if the things we hold and control are the most important reality. What did the rich man serve and what were his priorities? Reflect on v.31. What might this say to Christians who have forgotten our call and purpose?

Friday, October 3 Read 1 Timothy 6:6-19

We shape our behaviors around what matters most to us – what we ‘love.’ Here we are reminded that the love of money (and you could insert a number of things in the place of money as well) distracts us from our true position and purpose as set by God. Reflect a bit on vv.11-12. How does making this our focus protect us from investing ourselves in the wrong things?

Saturday, October 4 Read Psalm 146

Try memorizing vv.1-4 and reflect on them throughout the day, especially on the meaning of vv.3-4 for your life. How is this good news for you today? Are there areas of your life in which you need to grow in trust of the Lord? Share them with God in prayer today and be sure to listen for His answer.
