Daily Devotions & Scriptures

Monday, February 16 Read Leviticus 19:11-18

This passage ends with "...you must love your neighbor as yourself. I am the Lord." In what ways have you found loving your neighbor goes against your natural inclinations? How does embracing God's love (especially as embodied in Jesus) give you a clearer picture of how to love others?

Tuesday, February 17 Read Luke 6:27-31

Jesus seems to switch from a "do no harm," Old Testament style message to one of "do all the good you can." Is there a difference between knowing the Golden Rule and proactively seeking opportunities to practice it? Is Christ simply saying "be nice" or is there more to it?

Ash Wednesday, February 18 Read Luke 10:25-28

Is there a difference between not being thought of as a bad neighbor and being thought of as a good neighbor? Aside from your own reputation, does being a good neighbor have any effect on the image of Christ and Christianity? Is there at times a difference between how we should act and how we feel?

Thursday, February 19 Read 1 Peter 3:8-15

Have you noticed that the New Testament constantly reminds us to be humble? Why is humility so important to God? Is it important to our own quality of life? If so, how? Does humility have more to do with how we act or how we feel?

Friday, February 20 Read Romans 12:17-21

How does this passage speak against all forms of revenge in the case of another's bad behavior, and then encourage us to act contrary to how that person might expect us to act? Can you see a difference between rewarding bad behavior and acting more positively than your potential enemy might expect? How might such an attitude and action turn a relationship around?

Saturday, February 21 Read Galatians 5:13-16

What does "walk by the Spirit" mean to you? Although as Christians we may control our actions, do we sometimes indulge negative thoughts and feelings? What kinds of things can we do to reduce those thoughts and feelings towards others? How do we strengthen our ability to 'walk by the Spirit' in these circumstances?
