In consideration for participating in RBCY activities, the student (and parent/legal guardian) acknowledges and accepts the risks of injury associated with participation in and transportation to and from RBCY activities. The student accepts personal financial responsibility for any injury or other loss sustained during RBCY events, as well as for any medical treatment rendered to the student. Further, the student (or parent/legal guardian) releases and promises to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Rockford Baptist Church and its ministry partners for any injury arising directly or indirectly out of their participation in church events.

If a dispute over this agreement or any claim for damages arises, the student (or parent/legal guardian) agrees to resolve the matter through a mutually acceptable alternative dispute resolution process. If the student (or parent/legal guardian) and Rockford Baptist Church cannot agree upon such a process, the dispute will be submitted to a three-member arbitration panel for resolution pursuant to the rules of the American Arbitration Association.

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RBCY Behavior Agreement

We as leadership at RBCY desire to create a safe and enjoyable atmosphere for all students and to follow the commands of Scripture to love God and love our neighbor. We will do all we can within our power to make that happened, but also realize a large part of that is dependant up on our students' actions. All RBCY participants are asked to agree to the following:

We at RBCY have agreed to two broad sayings/rules: "Respect the People. Respect the Place." and "If you are going to be here, be here." While these rules are intentionally broad, it is meant to cover, at its basis, the following assumptions:

- Respect the People
 - I agree to respect and listen to the authority of RBCY leaders.
 - I agree to respect my fellow peers by choosing not to bully, use foul language, or threaten or carry out violence.
 - I will not bring any harmful items to youth outings including weapons, drugs, alcohol, pornographic material, etc.
- Respect the Place
 - I understand that the church and other facilities we visit are not my property and will do my best not to cause damage to property or take things that do not belong to me.
- If you are going to be here, be here
 - I agree not to leave the group/property before an event is over without notifying the pastor or leader in charge of an event.
 - I agree to be mentally, emotionally, and spiritually present, or at a minimum, not distract those around me.

Other specific events may have more stringent rules based on the location and nature of the events, but these are the minimum expectations for standard RBCY events.

RBCY leadership reserves the right to refuse entry or send home students who are deemed to be unsafe for the group or have otherwise violated this agreement in major/repeated ways.

Special Covid-19 Agreements

- I am aware of the WHO/CDC/KCHD social distancing guidelines and agree to respect the space of others.
- I agree to wash and sanitize my hands before and after using recreational material such as board games, sporting equipment, etc.
- I will not attend youth events if I currently have, or in the past 14 days, have had a fever or other symptoms and will alert the youth pastor if COVID related symptoms arise within 14 days after an activity.
- I understand that breaking this commitment is my own choice and potentially carries negative consequences for myself and my peers.
- I will under no circumstances shame, bully, or make any snarky remarks towards peers who's concern level differs from my own.
- I understand that the Youth Pastor and Volunteers can only enforce this through verbal request and cannot ensure these stipulations are followed 100% of the time.
