





JANUARY 2026 PRAYER & FASTING GUIDE

As we enter a new year, we seek clarity about who we are as God's people. Mission is not merely something we undertake — it is part of our identity. These daily prompts are crafted to help our congregation embrace who we are as a people sent into the world for the glory of Christ.

WE ARE A PEOPLE SENT BY JESUS

Day 1 - John 20:21

Pray that we will understand ourselves as a people sent—shaped by Jesus' own commission.

Day 2 - John 20:21

Ask God to deepen our awareness that being "sent" is central to our identity, not an optional task.

Day 3 - John 20:21

Pray that our church will enter 2026 with the confidence of people who know they are sent by Christ Himself.

Day 4 - Matthew 28:18

Pray that our identity will be anchored in Christ's authority rather than limited by our own abilities.

Day 5 - Matthew 28:19

Ask the Lord to form us into a disciple-making people—faithful in relationships and intentional with purpose.

Day 6 - Matthew 28:20

Pray that our confidence as a church will rest in Christ's abiding presence.

Day 7 - Reflection

Ask God to help each member live as one sent—attentive to people, open to opportunities, and ready to obey.

WEEK 2

WE ARE A PEOPLE EMPOWED & FORMED BY THE SPIRIT

Day 1 - Acts 6:1

Pray that we will recognize ourselves as a people who face real challenges yet trust God to guide us through them with unity and grace.

Day 2 - Acts 6:2-4

Ask the Lord to shape us into a church that prioritizes prayer and the ministry of the Word—the foundations of faithful mission.

Day 3 - Acts 6:3

Pray that the Spirit will raise up men and women of good reputation, full of wisdom and empowered by the Spirit, to serve faithfully in every ministry.

Day 4 - Acts 6:5-6

Pray for a spirit of unity—where decisions are made with humility and where the church gladly affirms God's work in one another.

Day 5 - Acts 6:7

Ask God to make us a fruitful people—bold in witness, steady in prayer, and confident that the gospel continues to multiply disciples.

Day 6 - Acts 6:8-10

Pray for courage like Stephen's: a life marked by grace, power, and unwavering truth even when we are opposed or misunderstood.

Day 7 - Acts 6:11-15

Ask God to form us into a people whose character reflects integrity, peace, and the unmistakable presence of Christ—even in moments of pressure or accusation.

WEEK

WE ARE A PEOPLE FORMED BY GOD'S STORY & FAITHFUL TO THE END

Day 1 - Acts 7:2-8

Pray that we will remember who we are by remembering where we come from—a people shaped by God's covenant faithfulness across generations.

Day 2 - Acts 7:9-16

Ask God to help us see that even in hardship, He is sovereign, present, and working out His purposes.

Day 3 - Acts 7:17-36

Pray that we will recognize ourselves as a people delivered by God and called to follow Him, even when His leading challenges our expectations.

Day 4 - Acts 7:37-43

Ask the Lord to guard our hearts against drifting toward idols—anything that competes for our loyalty or dulls our obedience.

Day 5 - Acts 7:44-50

Pray that we will understand that God's presence is not confined to places or traditions, but that He dwells with His people and sends us into the world.

Day 6 – Acts 7:51-53

Ask God to make us a repentant people—responsive to the Spirit, humble before Scripture, and willing to confront sin with honesty and hope.

Day 7 - Acts 7:54-60

Pray that we will embody Stephen's courage and Christlike mercy—a people faithful under pressure, generous in forgiveness, and confident in God to the very end.

WEEK 4

WE ARE A PEOPLE WHO CARRY THE GOSPEL WHEREVER GOD SENDS US!

Day 1 - Acts 8:1-4

Pray that we will understand ourselves as a people who carry the gospel even in seasons of disruption, hardship, or unexpected change.

Day 2 - Acts 8:4

Ask God to make us a church that proclaims the word wherever we go—not only in worship gatherings but in everyday life.

Day 3 - Acts 8:5-8

Pray that God will use our witness to bring joy to our communities as people hear and respond to the good news of Jesus.

Day 4 - Acts 8:9-24

Ask the Lord to guard our church from distorted motives—praying for pure hearts, sincere faith, and gospel-centered ministry.

Day 5 - Acts 8:26-29

Pray that we will become a Spirit-led people—attentive, obedient, and ready to go wherever the Lord directs.

Day 6 - Acts 8:30-35

Ask God to make us a people who explain the gospel clearly, patiently, and faithfully to those who are searching or confused.

Day 7 - Acts 8:36-40

Pray that we will celebrate every step of obedience and every transformed life, trusting that God will send us again to new places and new people for His glory.


CLOSING ENCOURAGEMENT


