We are excited to talk about the reopening of The Church at Quail Creek for worship on June 7th. To open, we will be doing things a little bit differently for a short while. For starters, we will only be doing **Sunday Worship Service** for a season. We must slowly roll back to our new normal, so please be patient with us.

You will notice some sizable differences as we meet. The first is only **Door 3** (facing Tascosa Road) and **Door 6** (facing the Quail Creek neighborhood) will be open for entry. If you are physically able, please use **Door 3** in order to leave parking closer to the doors for those that can't climb stairs to use **Door 6**.

Additionally, you will be asked to wear a mask for a little while in order to ensure the protection of those around us that may be vulnerable to COVID-19. We want to worship together and protect one another as we do so.

We will not be offering childcare, student ministry or adult Life Groups on campus for a while, so please visit **tcqc.org** for information on how to continue to participate in those groups online. As we move through best practice procedures, we will be slowly opening these ministries, so keep coming and let's celebrate as we begin these gatherings.

As you arrive on Sunday, you will be greeted by our team and pointed toward an usher that will assign you a seat in the sanctuary. By doing this, we can ensure social distancing and can get as many people in the sanctuary as possible. If you

are able, you will be asked to sit in the balcony to allow for those that cannot physically take the stairs to sit on the floor.

We will not be passing an offering plate but will instead have offering giving boxes. These will be located at the exits of our sanctuary. In addition, we will have a time of response during service but will not have an altar call. We instead will be asking you to respond through our website and a digital decision card.

If you feel ill or aren't comfortable attending at this time, we will be live streaming our services. We don't want you to feel left out or unloved during this season.

We know that all of this is strange and unconventional. Please bear with us. In time, we will get back to normal. I am praying for you and our church as we begin worship together again.
