

Costs of a Cruciate Repair using the Arthrex TightRope® Surgical technique 2018

The cost of the surgical procedure for a dog 51- 75lb is **\$2,250.**

(Small dogs are a little less and large dogs are a little more)

What is included?

- Surgery costs
- Genuine Arthrex TightRope® implant
- Anesthesia costs
- Monitoring, IV Fluids
- Pain medications administered in the hospital
- Antibiotics administered in the hospital
- 2 days of hospitalization
- All necessary medications to go home (30 days worth)
- Suture Removal Visit at 10 days
- Medical Progress Exam at 40 days

What is not included?

- Treatment for any unforeseen /concurrent diseases, conditions or complications that may or may not be known at the time of examination or surgery

We assume your dog was already diagnosed with a cruciate injury and your veterinarian has already completed a workup

What you need to bring us:

1. A generally healthy dog current on all vaccines and parasite prevention
2. Your dog's recent medical record of the injury
3. Radiographs of the knees and pelvis
 - a. Ventro-Dorsal view of the Pelvis with the knees in the same picture. Knees have to be straight
 - b. Lateral views of both knees, with the knee and tarsal joint at right angles
4. Basic Lab-work to include CBC, Chemistry and a total T4

Any part that is missing can be completed here (at an additional charge)

- *Radiographs (+/- Sedation) \$285 -\$450*
- *Pre-op Labs \$140-\$195 depending on the age of the patient*
