Health Care Recommendations for Your Cat

| <input type="checkbox"/> | Examination | We recommend two detailed examinations per year to ensure that your Cat is healthy. On average pets age 7 times faster than people. Examinations provide an opportunity to detect and prevent potential health problems as early as possible. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | Annual Wellness Test | For some adult cats we recommend an annual wellness blood test. Cats hide disease very effectively and many times conditions make themselves known far too late. A wellness blood test provides an opportunity to detect and address potential health problems as early as possible. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | “Distemper” Vaccination (FRCP) | Yearly Vaccination that protects against 3 important diseases: Feline Viral Rinotracheitis, Calicivirus, and Panleukopenia, which are highly contagious. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | Rabies Vaccination | Yearly vaccination. State law requires rabies vaccination. Rabies is a fatal viral disease that can be transmitted to humans. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | Feline Leukemia Vaccination | All cats that spend time unsupervised outdoors, or indoor cats that may come in contact with infected cats should be vaccinated. The virus is transmitted by cat bites and is fatal in most cases.. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | Blood Pressure | Recent research has made us aware that many cats suffer from hypertension. As in humans, hypertension can lead to serious and even fatal disease conditions. . |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | Intestinal Parasite Test | Fecal Flotation Test can detect the presence of intestinal parasites (intestinal worms and protozoa). Cats should be tested yearly. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | Feline Leukemia / Feline Aids Test | At-Risk cats, especially outdoors cats, should be tested yearly throughout their life. New kittens and cats should be tested for these life-threatening diseases before you introduce them into your household. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | Monthly Flea Control | The monthly prescription flea products Frontline® and Revolution®, offer safe, easy and highly effective flea control. Revolution® will also protect your cat against Ticks, roundworms, earmites, mange mites, and heartworms |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | Monthly Heartworm Prevention | Cats can be infected with the dog-heartworm. If a cat is infected with heartworms, it usually stops eating and has a cough or difficulty breathing. The disease is fatal in most cases.
