TIM'S TOP 3

The EQUIP Conference and the FCBA Annual Meeting were a great success! Thanks to everyone that worked so hard to make it happen. Here is a quick summary of the day. We had 33 churches represented, with a total attendance of 446. Pleasant Valley South did an awesome job hosting us. The breakout sessions were well attended and EVERYONE asked for more time to attend another topic. The music was GREAT and the

preacher was OK during the inspirational rally. In the business session we approved a budget of \$300,382.23 for 2024. That is an increase of \$24,027.84 over the 2023 budget and a monthly requirement of \$25,069.35. Please support the FCBA in your giving from your church. We elected officers Mac McCurry, Pastor at Pleasant Valley North, as Moderator; Eric Whelchel, Pastor at First Baptist - Lindale, as Moderator-Elect; and Jerry Dudley, Pastor at Pisgah, as Clerk. We took up a love offering totaling \$23,498.00 to go toward the Disaster Relief efforts in Floyd County and Lahaina on the Hawaiian Island of Maui. We also heard reports from all the ministry areas and approved the reports from all teams and committees. It was a busy day! We saw our mission statement: *"encouraging and equipping pastors and people to do the Great Commandment and the Great Commission"* and our nine priorities are *"praying, reaching, discipling, going, caring, growing, training, giving and next gen"* put into practice.

The FCBA 132nd Annual Meeting and Business Session will be held on Monday, September 23, 2024 from 6:00 - 8:30 pm at the FCBA Center in Rome. The FCBA and the Georgia Baptist Mission Board will be partnering together to bring you the SPARK Conference on Sunday, September 22, 2024 at West Rome Baptist Church from 3:30 - 8:30 pm. SPARK will be an event every FCBA church will want to attend plus we will be inviting churches from all over Northwest Georgia to attend. Our keynote speaker will be Thom Rainer, plus over 40 breakout session leaders! And YES you will get two sessions of breakout topics. We have not worked out all of the details, but the schedule will look something like this:

GEORGIA BAPTIST MISSION BOARD EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT





The most recent meeting of the Executive Committee (EC) of the Georgia Baptist Convention (GBC) was held on September 12, 2023 at Flat Creek Baptist Church in Fayetteville, Georgia.

The EC heard the final report for the financial audit conducted for 2022. The Georgia Baptist Mission Board (GBMB) continues to seek to remain above reproach and handle funds in a way that is pleasing to the Lord.

The Administration Committee (AC) was given the task of updating the organization documents of the EC. The updates were shared with the EC and were approved as presented.

During the annual session of the GBC in 2022 messengers asked President Josh Saefkow to appoint a committee to review the By-Laws of the GBC. This committee was chaired by Frank Cox. The updated By-Laws were approved by the EC and will be presented to the 2023 GBC for approval in November of 2023.

The EC heard an encouraging report of the work of the Georgia Baptist Disaster Relief teams in south Georgia following Hurricane Idalia. Hundreds of job requests were fulfilled and thousands of meals were prepared. Most importantly, the gospel was shared with a number of individuals.

The EC received the YTD financial report. The GBMB continues to operate in the black despite the continued decline of the Cooperative Program giving by Georgia Baptist churches.

An update was given on the status of the sale of the property on Sugarloaf. The property had been under contract with a local Gwinnett County group to purchase it; however, the group adjusted their offer with a significant reduction in their offer. The AC agreed to stay firm on the original offer. The prospective buyer removed their offer and terminated the contract. There continues to be interest expressed from other potential buyers; the broker will re-engage the interested parties. We continue to trust God will provide the right buyer at the right time.

The EC was reminded that while September is the emphasis month for Mission Georgia, we can pray and give to Mission Georgia throughout the year. Georgia is our mission field.

An update on the SPARK events was encouraging. With a SPARK event in each of the six regions of Georgia, there were over 2,000 registrants and almost 300 churches in attendance. This is a total church conference to assist our churches through training and inspiration. The Floyd County Baptist Association will be hosting a regional SPARK conference in 2024.

Pastor Wellness has added 3 part-time ladies to their team to work with ministry wives. Jennifer Williams will be in the southern regions, Lauren Walker will serve in the northern regions, and Suzette Green will serve the central regions.
