Sunday School Programming for January through May 2019

January 6, February 3, March 3, April 7, May 5 – first Sunday of the month

- Children in K through 5th grade should come directly to the DuVall Chapel (2nd floor, next to elevator) at 10:30 a.m. for *Opening Chapel*, a 15-minute children's worship experience. Children will then travel with their teachers to their respective classrooms.
- Children ages 2 through 4 should go directly to their respective Sunday School classrooms. At 10:45 a.m., the preschool teachers will escort their students to the DuVall Chapel for their own children's worship experience, returning to their individual classrooms at 11:00.
- Youth in grades 6 through 12 will attend the 10:30 worship service.

January 13 & 27, February 10 & 17, March 10 & 17, April 21 & 28, May 5 & 19

- Children in K through 5th grade should come directly to the DuVall Chapel (2nd floor, next to elevator) at 10:30 a.m. for *Opening Chapel*, a 15-minute children's worship experience. Children will then travel with their teachers to their respective classrooms.
- Children ages 2 through 4 should go directly to their respective Sunday School classrooms. At 10:45 a.m., the preschool teachers will escort their students to the DuVall Chapel for their own children's worship experience, returning to their individual classrooms at 11:00.
- Youth in grades 6 through 12 go directly to their respective Sunday School classrooms.

January 20, February 24, March 24, April 14, May 12 – Children's Sunday

- All children age two to 5th grade should come to the Sanctuary with their families for worship until they are dismissed to Sunday School following the *Young People's Message*.
- Children will have an opportunity to sing an anthem together during the 10:30 worship service. This will be a song the children learn during Chapel Time on 1/6 and 1/13.
- There will be no Opening Chapel on this day.
- Youth in grades 6 through 12 go directly to their respective Sunday School classrooms.

May 19 – last day of the 2018-2019 Sunday School year!

May 26 – Summer Sunday School begins!

- From Memorial Day through mid-July, children age two to 5th grade should come to the Sanctuary with their families at 10:30 when they will be invited forward for the *Young People's Message*, after which they will transition to Summer Sunday School in Rooms 200 and 203.

For Children in Preschool through 5th Grade:

- **Once a month**, St. Paul's celebrates **Children's Sunday**, and all children in preschool through 5th grade should come directly to the Sanctuary with their families at 10:30 on these days. Children will be called forward for the *Young People's Message*, after which they will transition to their classrooms for Sunday School lessons. **Children's Sunday** dates for 2019 are **January 20, February 24, March 24, April 14, and May 12.**
- **On all other Sundays**, beginning **January 6**, children in grades K through 5 start the Sunday School hour in the DuVall Chapel for a 15-minute **Opening Chapel** worship experience before going to their Sunday School classrooms. Children ages 2-4 begin in their individual classrooms; their teachers will escort them to the chapel at 10:45 for their own worship experience and will lead them back to their classrooms at 11:00.

For Middle and Senior High Youth:

- **On the first Sunday of every month**, students in 6th through 12th grades attend worship in the Sanctuary at 10:30.
- **On all other Sundays**, students in grades 6-8 will attend the middle high Sunday School class in Room 117, and students in 9-12 grades will attend the senior high class in the Youth Lounge.

Dismissal / Student Pick-Up: If your child is in 3rd grade or younger, please plan to pick them up after Sunday School. If your child is to be picked up by someone other than you (including an older sibling), please make those arrangements personally with your child's teacher. Children 4th grade and older can be dismissed without a parent present, but you are welcome to pick them up as well.

Snacks: We do serve snacks most Sundays, usually goldfish, Teddy Grahams, and/or pretzels. The teachers sometimes bring other treats so ***please make your child's teacher aware of any potential allergy issues.*** Please do this even if you have shared your child's allergy information in the past in the event the information has not been passed along to your child's new teacher.
