BIBLE APP FOR KIDS: "Let My People Go!" (house with blood on doorpost icon)

REFLECTIONS:

- ♦♦♦ What was the man's name in the story that God used to talk to Pharaoh?
- ♦♦♦ When Pharaoh refused to let God's people go, God sent 10 different warnings, called "Plagues". Do you remember some of them? Which one would have been the worst to you?
- ♦♦♦ Living under Pharaoh's reign seems unbearable. The plagues equally as miserable and horrific. Having to slaughter the best lamb to put the blood over the door to be safe from losing your first born son - terrifying. God taking the people out of Egypt probably felt like the greatest rescue ever. However, an even greater rescue was coming. What was that rescue? Yes - Jesus! Just as the oldest son can point to the lamb and say, 'That lamb died instead of me', a Christ follower can point to Jesus and say, 'Jesus died instead of me'.
