Though we live in many different "homes" here on earth, our ultimate longing is for our eternal home with God.

As we step into August—with the Boone County Fair, the start of a new school year, and all the busyness it brings—may we hold on to the spiritual practices that help us remember our true home in heaven. Let us continue to encourage one another as we walk this journey together.




#### **Generosity and Cheerful Giving**
