The Church: Becoming the Central Square of Our Lives

*"How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!" Psalm 133:1 (NIV)*

Although I have never been to Europe, I discovered a fascinating characteristic of old European cities while watching a historical documentary. As you walk through the narrow, complex, and winding alleys—just when you begin to wonder if you are lost—the view suddenly opens up, and a grand town square (Piazza) appears before your eyes. There, residents sip coffee, children run around, neighbors greet one another, and the community gathers to discuss matters big and small. Though the alleys stretch out in completely different directions, they all ultimately converge at this central square.

During a recent meeting about our church's future ministries, this image of the town square came to my mind. Even though our church is not physically located in the heart of downtown Belvidere, I dream of our community becoming a spiritual and cultural “central square” for this region and for the lives of our congregants.

Last week, we held our very first Town Hall Meeting. It was a precious time to share the direction our church is moving in, and to listen to the valuable suggestions and questions of our congregation. To some, the challenges of ministry might feel like a complex maze of alleys, but the conversations we shared that day were beautiful pathways leading us toward a “healthier community.” The feedback and engagement you offered will serve as the foundation for transforming our church into an even more vibrant town square. Now, June is upon us, bringing the official start of summer.

Schools are let out for break, and our college students are making their welcome return home, adding a joyful bustle to our church square. At the same time, because of summer vacations, we might find ourselves busy with travel, and parts of our square may feel momentarily empty. Yet, our ministries continue to move forward. In mid-June, we will host Camp Rock Forward to serve and love foster children. Soon after, at the end of June, our youth and leaders will head out on the ASP mission trip, blazing a trail of love toward our neighbors. Furthermore, preparation for July's VBS will bring an extra layer of energy and life to our church.

We will all be busy walking down different alleys of summer activities and schedules. However, every single one of these steps ultimately leads to the same square: a community united in the love of Jesus Christ.

This summer, amidst our hectic daily routines, I hope you find a place to pause, breathe, and connect at our church—a community that welcomes you like an open town square. May you find joy in untangling your weary hearts and walking together in fellowship.

## Spiritual Gifts: Serving Through Divine Empowerment

### The Concept of Spiritual Gifts

Spiritual gifts, as conferred by the Holy Spirit, are unique abilities granted to believers. These gifts are intended for the edification of the church and the glorification of God. They are a manifestation of the Spirit's work in and through believers, enabling them to serve the church and the world in various capacities.

### Biblical Illustrations

#### The Variety of Gifts (1 Corinthians 12:4-11)

This passage in Corinthians elucidates the diversity and purpose of spiritual gifts, emphasizing their integral role in the Christian community. It highlights that while the gifts are varied, they are all given by the same Spirit for the common good.

#### The Gift of Prophecy (Acts 21:9)

The daughters of Philip, who had the gift of prophecy, exemplify the manifestation and significance of spiritual gifts in the early church. Their ability to prophesy was a clear demonstration of how spiritual gifts were utilized for edification and guidance within the Christian community.

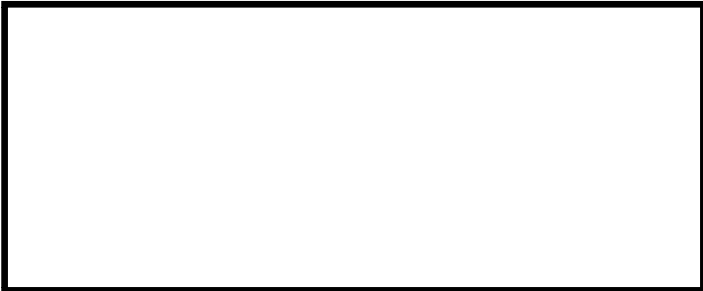
