Many of you have heard me speak of my studies for a Doctor of Ministry degree. I feel like Don Quixote, an old fool tilting at windmills. The program helps new clergy establish a robust pastoral identity and effective practice of ministry. The head of the program is a trusted colleague. But how will it help our congregation? I wasn't sure.

One of the benefits of enrollment is that I am assigned a clergy coach and a spiritual director for the duration. As we got acquainted, he became interested in our congregation and I got interested in his method. We thought we might be able to work together. The seminary will pay him to come and lead us through an assessment of our current church life and start thinking about our future. Eureka! We are entering another new phase in the life of our congregation which calls for a clear picture of our current reality and an equally clear and shared vision for our next chapter.


For us to take advantage of this rare, grant-funded opportunity, most of us will complete a survey; almost 100 questions about the life of the church. You can take the survey on-line, or fill out a paper copy and one of us will submit it on-line. We will publish a link to the survey on our website and the QR code for those who will use their phone to complete the survey. Please allow time to complete the whole thing at one sitting (30-50 minutes) and answer all the questions marked with an *. Each week we'll get a report of how many folks have responded. We don't know who has and who hasn't, so we'll keep everyone updated.

On October 18 our leaders will gather to hear the results and the report of our coach. We'll start considering what might be next for First Church. On October 19 we'll have our Stewardship Celebration brunch, for any who would like to attend. Coach Jaye will give a report to as many as would like to stay, listen, ask questions and discuss.

I am thrilled by this opportunity, at exactly the time in our life and my ministry when it will be of most benefit. I am empowered by the enthusiasm of the folks who are already preparing to make sure your voice is heard and their commitment that this information won't gather dust on a shelf somewhere. Looking back, I am amazed at what God has done among us in the time I've been here. Looking forward, I know we face challenges we haven't seen before, without a seminary textbook to explain what to do. I believe our unchanging God is getting ready to do more. I think that maybe this survey and the coaching that comes with it are an instrument God has made available to light our path and bring about some new thing we wouldn't have believed if we had been told in advance.

The Promise of Blessing for Faithful Giving


The Bible teaches that faithful giving leads to God's blessings. When we give in obedience, God promises to provide for us and bless us abundantly.
