CLC Status Update

2022 was a very good year for the CLC! We currently have full enrollment (80) with 154 on the waiting list. We should be able to accommodate at least 50 additional children when the new building is finished. The total income for 2022 was \$452,575 with total expenses \$391,062. This left an income of \$61,513 for the year. There are currently 14 full-time and 4 part-time employees. A dietician will be hired once the KCLC is finished. Planning is also ongoing for staffing. Once again, we would like to thank you for your amazing support.
