#### **Construction Update July** 2023

The KCLC continues to evolve into an amazing place for children! We wanted to give you a brief synopsis of the current state of the construction.

The month of July is seeing some very tangible progress. Included in this is pouring concrete for the mezzanine and outside columns, window installation, veneer blocking, framing of the porch and drive thru, storm drain installations, setting columns and beams for the porch and drive-thru, and HVAC duct installation. Ongoing throughout the month will be setting metal roof panels, electrical wiring, sprinkler system, and plumbing.

The interior colors have been chosen throughout (different shades of grays with blues) and exterior brick chosen to match the church. The personalized bricks from the original fundraiser have been received. Most importantly, security matters have been discussed in depth and the decision made to enhance the safety of the facility. This has become a priority at the construction meetings, while also considering financial reality.
