

Cornhole Rules:

1. The boards will be 27 feet apart from front edge to front edge.
2. Teammates must stand at opposite ends of the board.
3. Opponents standing at the same board will throw one bag at a time at the opposite board until each player at that board throw 4 bags apiece.
4. While throwing, you must stay behind the front of the board. If you step past the front of the board, your throw will be counted a miss.
5. 3 points are given for each bag in the hole, 1 point for each on the board. Any bag that is on the board and touching the ground does not count.
6. Add up how many points you earned and compare them to your opponents. Equal points cancel each other out so that only one team can score per round. For example, if you scored 5 points and your opponent scored 3, you will add 2 points to your overall score and your team will throw first in the next round.
7. Players must deliver the bag with an underhand release.
8. A game is won when a team reaches 21 points exactly with a lead of 2 or more points.
9. If a team scores over 21 points or “busts” they will be reduced to 11 points.
10. Unless there is a tie, the game will conclude after 13 rounds. Whoever is ahead after 13 rounds wins.
11. If there is a tie at 13 rounds, the first one to take the lead (by any amount) will win the game.
12. Teams may only be made up of two players. You cannot use a different player on your team once you signup.
13. You may only play on one Cornhole Team
