



Water Skiing/Wakeboarding at the Bay

Alton Bay Christian Conference Center offers water ski/wakeboard lessons for youth and teens. Our dedicated staff have years of experience on and behind the boat and are happy to teach new skills that will improve your ability with just a few pulls.

The water ski/wakeboard program will start on July 3, 2017 and end on August 11, 2017. So it is time to roll out of bed extra early and meet us at the Front Bay Dock just to the left of the Mount Washington Dock. Monday - Friday at 7:15 am (weather permitting). At 7:15 there will be a short devotional followed by a timeslot to ski for all skiers and wakeboarders.

We have licensed drivers, certified lifeguards and shoreline coordinators available to instruct and help you become successful in the water.

Questions and Answers about the Ski Ministry



Question 1. Do I need to sign a waiver before I ski/wakeboard?

Yes. Permission slips are mandatory and can be found at the Alton Bay office <http://altonbay.org/> or you can click on the link <https://goo.gl/MxqBTP>

Question 2. How long is the water ski season?

Our program will operate for 6 weeks in the summer. It begins on July 3rd, 2017 and will end on August 11, 2017.

Question 3. Does a parent/guardian need to be present when I ski/wakeboard?

There is always a risk of injury when participating in any ski/wakeboard activity. A parent should be present on the shore at all times for children who are under 11 years of age. Parents of older children are encouraged to support and cheer on their child when they ski/wakeboard.

Question 4. Am I allowed to walk alone to the ski dock area?

Due to the safety and liability of the children participating in the ski ministry your child should be escorted to and from the ski/wakeboard dock area. The main road can be very busy at that time in the morning.

Question 5. How long will I have to wait before I ski?

Wait time varies depending on the number of participants. We ski/wakeboard approximately from 7:15am - 11:00 AM weather permitting. Each person participating will sign their name in before 7:15am and then may stay or return at the allotted time to ski/wakeboard. Check with the shore line coordinator for your time.

Question 6. How much does it cost?

This program is funded by generous supporters and donations, so the program is free. We will have a few opportunities for you to attend a fundraiser at Jay's Mini Golf, participate in our corn toss tournament held at the Bay and participate in our bake sale on the beach and front bay. Check the office for dates and times.

Question 7. What equipment do I need?

The ski/wakeboard ministry provides all equipment needed to water ski or wakeboard. We have all sizes of life jackets, helmets, skis, wake boards, and wetsuits available.

Question 9. What do I need to know when I water ski or wakeboard?

Waiver, towel, any ski/wakeboard gear and a snack.
