Now that we are all full of turkey and pumpkin pie, next up is the Advent season. Starting next Sunday, Pastor Zack and I will begin a series titled "Upside-Down Christmas". In this series, we will be exploring the Birth and Resurrection of Jesus; Jesus' dad, Joseph; and the Wise Men. As a result of the loss of nearly \$4,500 in rental income from the apartment in the Parsonage, along with a few other additional surprises, we are on track to end 2018 fiscal year with a deficit in the General Fund of right around \$7,000.00! Because we have excess funds in other accounts, we have been easily able to cover that deficit without having to go into our available line of credit from the bank. The challenge is to prayerfully consider making an additional gift to the Church during this season of giving. The Board has already taken budgetary action to reduce spending, but we need YOU to step up and help. "Keep Your Hand To The Plow."
