As you should know by now, my ethnicity is that I am partially Polish. For some unexplainable and strange reason, in the 1960's through the 1970's, Polish jokes became popular. Polish jokes (also known as Pollack Jokes) are jokes based on negative stereotypes, and meant to mock Poles, their Polish culture or their habits.
